SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

1. By way of instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, petitioners have approached this Court *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing impugned order dated 16.01.2024, Annexure P-7, passed by respondent No.1. Another prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to decide application dated 24.01.2024, Annexure P-8, filed by the petitioners for vacation of ex-parte stay order dated 16.01.2024, Annexure P-8.

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2. Pursuant to the previous order passed by this Court, Mr. Aman Bahri, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, has produced the original record from respondent No.1. He submits that the application, Annexure P-8, was duly considered by the revisional authority on 25.01.2024 and it was ordered that the interim order shall continue. He submits that the petitioner has taken a wrong stand before this Court. He has instructions to state that the revision petition was adjourned in April, 2024, on a request made on behalf of counsel for the petitioner and it is now fixed for 27.06.2024.

3. Be that as it may, since a revision petition filed by the private respondents, is pending, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to conclude its hearing and decide it within a period of six months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.
