1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to look into the matter and to take legal action against the private respondents No.5 to 14 in accordance with law.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if representation dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) is looked into and decided, as it is evidently a case wherein the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Iqbalpreet Singh, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural to look into the representation dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law expeditiously.
