JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. On 24.03.2023, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the application which was filed by him for issuance of passport has not been finalized by the respondent-Passport Authorities on the ground that there was one FIR No.93 dated 21.04.1997 under Excise Act in which the learned Magistrate has only imposed fine of Rs. 250/- and that too in the year 1997 and that cannot become a ground for denial of passport to the petitioner.

Ms. Amrita Singh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to seek instructions in this regard.
