1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 24.11.2023 passed in CWP-26488-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 24.11.2023 passed in CWP-26488-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 12.12.2023 has been passed.
