1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 24.02.2003 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2, vide which the benefit of proficiency step up increment granted to the petitioner w.e.f. 19.02.1996 on completion of 18 years of service, has been withdrawn.
2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 17.05.2024, notice was ordered to be issued to he petitioner.
3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report “not residing at the given address”.
4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
