1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.49 dated 24.03.2022, registered under Section 63 of Copy Right Act, 1957 and Section 420 of IPC, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rashpal Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 28.03.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 19.03.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
