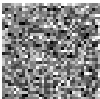

1. Through the instant petition, under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.8 dated 06.01.2023, (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406, 420, 370 and 386 of IPC, and under Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, at Police Station Kharar, District, SAS Nagar, Mohali, in which Sections 364-A and 120-B of IPC were added later on.
2. Vide order dated 23.07.2024, after hearing the learned counsel for the parties concerned, at length, the following directions were issued:-

1. The petitioner (in CRM-M-14303-2024) is directed to, within 10 days, surrender before the learned trial Court concerned. In case, the petitioner surrenders and files a regular bail application, the learned trial Court concerned is directed to release him on interim bail, subject to its satisfaction.



2. List on 12.08.2024.

3. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to place on record whether compliance of the impugned order has been made or not. 4. Also, Registry of this Court is directed to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner (in CRM-M-56962-2023) about the next date of hearing.

5. A photocopy of this order be placed on file of each connected case

3. In pursuance to the directions (supra), the petitioner could not surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, and thereupon, vide order dated 07.08.2024, the petitioner was further granted 07 days time to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned.

4. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has caused appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, and he has been released on regular bail by the learned trial Court concerned on 09.08.2024.

5. In view of the above, order dated 23.07.2024, is hereby, made absolute.

6. The instant petition is **disposed** of accordingly.
