1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order Annexure P-12 passed by respondent No.1, whereby the Punjab Government notification dated 26.02.1990 has been withdrawn, denying to count the services rendered by the petitioner under the Government of India.

2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the parties on 21.05.2024, therefore, notices were ordered to be issued to the parties for 05.08.2024.

3. As per office report notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that he is not residing at the given address; notices issued to respondents No.1, 3 and 4 have been received back served and notice issued to respondent No.2 has not been received back served or otherwise.
