Petition under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') has been filed for cancellation of bail pending trial granted to respondent No.2-Anil Kumar vide order dated 04.03.2024 (P-2) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh in No.FIR No.06 dated 03.02.2024, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 & 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, 'the IPC'), registered at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.
