Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for protection of life and liberty of the present petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 9 and for directing respondent No.3 to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the veracity of the allegations contained in the present petition have been thoroughly examined by the concerned jurisdictional police authorities and it has been concluded that there is no threat perception and the police has already initiated security proceedings under Section 107/151 Cr.P.C. against the private respondents and one of the assailants in the FIR No.173 dated 12.10.2017 registered under Sections 354-D/341/506 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Kurali filed at the behest of the daughter of the petitioner and the main accused Sunil

Kumar has been convicted by the trial Court. The allegations in the entire case are

against Sunil Kumar, who stands convicted.

In view of the above, no further direction is required to be issued  
and the present petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
