1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondent No.3 to grant premature release to the petitioner in case FIR No.215 dated 22.06.2010 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 449, 120-B, 216 of the IPC and sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that he will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide his representation dated 16.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) within a stipulated time frame.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Jail Superintendent, Central Jail-I, Hisar to look into the representation dated 16.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of next two months.
