NAMIT KUMAR J. (Oral)

The petitioner is aggrieved against the order dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-4), whereby the petitioner has been re-transferred from the office of Senior XEN (Electrical)/DS Division City, Pathankot to the office of Senior XEN (Electrial)/APDR P Cell, Gurdaspur.

It is the case of the petitioner that due to family problems of the petitioner, he submitted a request for his transfer from Gurdaspur to Pathankot and the said request was accepted vide order dated 14.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) and he was transferred to Pathankot where, he joined on 15.02.2024. However, after a period of 30 days, he has been re-transferred from Pathankot to Gurdaspur. He further submits that the daughter of the petitioner, who is 16 years old, is suffering from Cerebral Palsy and is bed ridden, unable to sit or stand as she is also suffering from Fits and is having 80% permanent disability. He has old

aged parents, aged about 83 and 85 years, respectively and are not keeping good health and are heart patients. The son of the petitioner is studying in 8th class. The petitioner is required to take care of all of them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that he shall submit a detailed representation against the impugned transfer dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-4), keeping in view the above difficulties being faced by him, and the same may be considered and decided by the respondents in a time bound manner.

Let the petitioner submit a representation within a period of 01 week from today and the same shall be considered and decided by the competent authority – respondent No.2, within a period of 03 weeks thereafter, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing.

Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
