1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, but with liberty to raise the statutory appeal, for thereby, the present petitioner impugning Annexures P-32 and P-33. If the statutory appeal is time barred, thereupon, the present petitioner may file an application cast under Section 14 of the Limitation Act, and, upon the said application, a well considered order be promptly passed, and, thereafter the statutory appeal be registered, and, be decided within a period of two months thereafter. In the decision making process to be embarked upon by the Appellate Authority upon the said statutory appeal, it shall grant a reasonable opportunity of hearing to all affected persons concerned.
2. Moreover, in case some interim relief is asked for, by the present petitioner, thereupon the said application be decided most justly and fairly.
