JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. On 21.03.2024, the following order was passed:
- “Mr. Anurag Goyal, Advocate submits that case of the petitioners for promotion was considered by Selection Committee. The said Committee has prepared its recommendations and put up before Board of Governors. The recommendations of the Committee were not put up before BOG on account of pendency of CWP-19409-2024. The said writ petition stands disposed of vide judgment dated 22.09.2023. The BOG in its 65th meeting held on 06.03.2024 has considered the issue, however, no final decision has been taken.*

The respondents are expected to complete their formalities and decide fate of the petitioners before the adjourned date.

2. Mr. Anurag Goyal, Advocate submits that during the pendency of present petition, BOG has opened sealed result and found petitioners eligible for the claimed post. As per his instructions, the Management has agreed to implement recommendations of the Committee after completion of period of Model Code of Conduct.
3. Mr. A.S. Virk, Advocate does not dispute the aforesaid statement and submits that result would be implemented on the end of Model Code of Conduct.
4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
