1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-State has submitted that the order dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been passed by the Haryana Government by virtue of which 18 officers have been posted and transferred in compliance with the Election Commissioner, Government of India's instructions dated 21.12.2023 and also the transfer policy dated 24.02.2024, in view of the ensuing elections. It is further submitted that neither the said instructions have been placed on record nor are under challenge and the postings/transfers have been done in order to have a fair and free election. It is stated that

respondent No.4, in pursuance of the impugned order dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) has already joined the place of his posting and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to rebut the said aspect.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
