The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.180 dated 05.09.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) 2014 at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.03.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
