

**IN THE HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA
AT CHANDIGARH**

“Anil Sharma Vs. State of Punjab and anr.” decided on 28.04.2021 and the respondents have already issued Instructions dated 02.09.2024 withdrawing the said Instructions hence, the reason given by the respondents to deny the benefit no longer exists.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the claim of the petitioner for the grant of salary of the higher post will be re-considered keeping in view of the Instructions which have been issued by the Government of Punjab dated 02.09.2024 by which, the Instructions dated 14.12.2016 have been withdrawn, and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner as well for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
