Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for setting-aside the order dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, vide which the petitioner has been posted to DS Sub-Division Bhikhiwind from DS Sub-Division Kot Mit Singh, by ignoring the transfer policy dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent No.2. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for staying the operation of the order dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-2), during the pendency of the writ petition.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to submit a detailed representation within one week before the respondents with regard to the grievance as raised in the present petition.

Mr. R.P.S. Bara, Advocate, who is present in the Court, on receipt of advance copy of the writ petition, submits that if any such representation is moved by the petitioner within a period of 01 week, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No.3, within a period of 01 month thereafter.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

Till the representation submitted by the petitioner is considered and decided by the competent authority, the transfer order dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) shall not be given effect, qua the petitioner.
