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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. The present Public Interest Litigation raises the alleged public cause that irregularities and illegalities including corruption is being committed in the office of Regional Transport Authority, Ludhiana.
2. On the insistence of this Court, short reply by way of affidavit accompanied by various Annexures including R-1, which is a report by the Regional Transport Officer, Ludhiana, has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. The same is taken on record. The report indicates that scientific method is adopted to conduct driving tests and the allegation of corruption is denied.
3. Be that as it may, this Court would not like to enter into the merits of the allegations made by the petitioner, nor the defence of the State of Punjab, for sole reason that the instant petition is vague and lacks in material particulars.



4. However, the petitioner is always free to approach the concerned authority including the Lokayukta or the concerned Magistrate by invoking Section 175(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, if at all his grievance is not addressed.
5. The petition stands disposed of.
