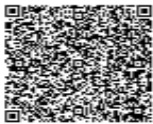

The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.75 dated 21.05.2023 under Sections 295-A, 323, 324, 307, 427, 452, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 295-A IPC deleted and Section 295 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

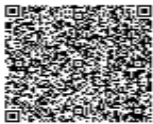
The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 21.03.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
