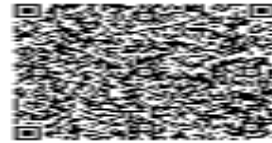

1. Challenge in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the notification dated 20.07.1993 (Annexure P-4), issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, the 'Act') and the notification dated 19.07.1994 (Annexure P-6) issued under Section 6 of the Act, whereby acquisition proceedings were initiated for the public purpose namely for setting up of residential urban estate in the area of Tehsil Bathinda, District Bathinda.

2. None was present for the petitioner on 04.05.2022, 16.05.2022, 23.05.2022, 12.07.2022 and 29.11.2023. On 08.04.2024, notice was sent to the petitioner which exercise was repeated on 30.04.2024. As per the office report, fresh notice could not be issued to the petitioner for want of complete address. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present litigation.

3. Accordingly, in view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
