1. Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in the case bearing FIR No.397 dated 03.11.2022 under Sections 148/149/307/170/420/279/336/427/120-B IPC, 1860 and Section 25-1B (1) of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Narwana, District Jind.
2. Custody certificate has been filed. The same is taken on record.
3. As per the allegations levelled in the FIR, it was alleged that the petitioner is stated to be the driver of the vehicle in which the accused were travelling. Challan stands presented. The petitioner is behind the bars for a period of 01 year, 04 months and 25 days. Till now, none of the 21 cited witnesses has been examined despite the fact that almost all the witnesses are official witnesses.
4. Counsel for the petitioner further relies upon the order dated 09.02.2024 passed in CRM-M-52752-2023, wherein, the co-accused stand admitted to bail.
5. Learned State counsel is not in a position to dispute the aforesaid aspects.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the records of the case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the incarceration suffered by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
