1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to complete recruitment process for the post of Watchman which was initiated vide recruitment notice dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P-1).
2. The petitioners claim that pursuant to advertisement dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P-1), they participated in the selection process and have been selected after passing written and physical test.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Sunlish Bindlish, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.
5. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.
6. Mr. Sunlish Bindlish, Advocate submits that FCI has issued show cause notice to recruitment agency because there are discrepancies in the recruitment process. The matter is under consideration and final decision would shortly be taken.
