The Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court is directed to submit a report on or before the next date of hearing containing the following information:-

- 1. Number of persons arraigned as accused;
- 2. Whether any accused is proclaimed offender;
- 3. Whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence;
- 4. Whether the accused persons are involved in any other case or not;
- 5. The trial Court is also directed to record the statement of the Investigating Officer as to how many victims/complainants are there in the FIR and apprise this Court about the stage of proceedings?

The report of the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court be awaited for 04.07.2023.

Status report/reply on behalf of State be also filed on the adjourned date.”

3. There is no representation on behalf of the parties, however, in compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834* and *Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63* and Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.0001 dated 06.01.2018 under Sections 420/120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Cantt Ferozepur, District Ferozepur and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners
