1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.12.2019 passed in CWP-29451-2019.

2. Short reply dated 15.06.2022 by way of affidavit of Shyam Lal Poonia, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

3. Although vide order dated 19.12.2019 passed in CWP-29451-2019, the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri, was directed to decide the representation moved by the petitioner, however, counsel for the respondents has pointed out that the matter has already been amicably settled between the parties. Even Maya Devi, wife of the petitioner, has made a separate statement that she is residing alone in the house and she has no objection, if her husband (petitioner herein) resides alongwith her.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-
addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate
remedy, but in accordance with law.
