This is an application for recalling of order dated 22.03.2024
passed by this Court.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is
allowed. The order dated 22.03.2024 qua stoppage of salary is recalled.

CM-6840-CII-2024

This is an application for preponing the date of hearing in the
main case.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Ashish Handa, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the
non-applicant/petitioner and submits that he has no objection, if the present
application is allowed.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and in view of no
objection given by the counsel opposite, the application is allowed. The
main case is preponed and taken up for hearing today itself.

Main Case

This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 17.03.2022 passed in CRM-M-50429-2021.

Learned State counsel, who is being assisted by Smt. Rupinder Kaur, Superintendent of Police, Phagwara, has submitted that the respondent has left the country and, therefore, he could not be arrested. However, every earnest effort is being made to bring him back to the country; by writing to the concerned Embassy and the Authorities.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition, any more. Accordingly, the same is dismissed, at this stage.

However, when the respondent is brought back to India, the petitioner would be at liberty to file the contempt petition once again.

The presence of aforesaid officer is exempted.
