HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003; the benefits have been accorded to her and upon necessary calculations, case of the petitioner already stands forwarded to the Finance Department and the financial benefits shall be released to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at

liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
