1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.3 whereby the petitioner has been prematurely retired.
