1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to take strict legal action in accordance with law against the private respondents and their accomplices, who have allegedly defrauded and looted the petitioner of all his money and property.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions from Yudhveer Singh from Police Station Women Cell, Sector 17, Chandigarh has submitted that the petitioner appeared before the official respondents and withdrew the complaint dated 26.02.2024 by contending that he would instead approach the police at Yamuna Nagar.

3. In view of the instructions received by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not press the instant petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
