1. Through the instant petition, petitioner, who is a complainant, has approached this Court for issuance of a *mandamus* upon the official respondents to entrust the investigation of the case FIR no.53, dated 26.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, to some independent agency, or the investigation may be supervised by some senior IPS rank police officer.

2. This Court vide order dated 01.04.2024, directed the State to file a status report with regard to the investigation in the instant FIR.

3. In deference to the directions issued vide order (*supra*), today, learned State counsel, during the course of hearing has filed a status report dated 12.08.2024, by way an affidavit of Sh.Babandeep Singh, DSP, Sub-Division Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, which is

ordered to be taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. The status report (*supra*), reflects that the investigation in the instant matter has already been completed, and further learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Joginder Singh, informs this Court that after completion of the investigation, the final report so prepared by the investigating officer, will be filed before the learned Illaqa Magistrate concerned, within two weeks from today.

5. In view of the aforesaid changed circumstances, as well as the statement suffered by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he does not want press the instant petition.

6. Therefore, the instant petition is hereby **dismissed as not pressed**, at this stage. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner, that in case, if any grievances is left to the petitioner, he can raise the same before the learned *Illaqa* Magistrate concerned, by filing an appropriate motion.
