The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondents for willfully, intentionally, *malafidely* and deliberately, disobeying and not complying with the order dated 15.03.2023 passed by the Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division, Mohinderghar in Civil Suit No. 190 of 2019.

Heard.

Since the petitioner is having an alternate and effective remedy before the Executing Court qua execution of the decree, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
