1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of the impugned order dated 04.02.2004 (Annexure P-1) and further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents to give the petitioners pay-scale of Rs.2200-4000/- (with initial start of Rs.2400/-) w.e.f. 01.01.1986, Rs.7750-13300/- (with initial start of Rs.8550/-), w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as has been given to other employees by the Punjab as well as Center Government to the similarly situated employees.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 15.10.2024, learned counsel for the petitioners sought an adjournment to get the instructions from the petitioners. Today, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite his best efforts, he could not get the instructions from the petitioners.

3. In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed in default for want of prosecution.

4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
