The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer to transfer the investigation in case FIR No.21 dated 02.02.2018 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Batinda, District Bathinda to some independent investigating agency.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, after completing the investigation a final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented before the Court against respondent No.5. He further contends that in the present case, charge was ordered to be framed against the accused and four witnesses have already been examined by the trial Court.
