1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and Mr. Sirat Sapra, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of private respondents and submits that private respondents have no objection to the marriage and thus there cannot be any threat perception to the petitioners.
4. As per petitioners, they have married on 17.03.2024 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8, who happen to be the relatives of petitioner No.1 i.e. Ramandeep Kaur.
5. Both the petitioners claim themselves to be major stating that petitioner No.1-Ramandeep Kaur is 15.05.2003 born and petitioner

No.2-Sunny is 15.04.1998 born as per their Aadhar Cards.

6. Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 18.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioners.

7. Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 8 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.

8. The petition stands disposed off.
