1. The present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India has been preferred by the petitioners seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.3 and 4.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from ASI Nirmaljeet Singh, P.S. Sujampur (Rural) has produced in Court a copy of statement of the petitioner to the fact that earlier she had apprehension from the private respondents but now she has no apprehension from them and does not require any protection as of now.
4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to file the

same afresh with better particulars, if so required, in future.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
