Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.PC seeking quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1), and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-2). Details of the FIR are as under: -

With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

3. Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, vide report dated 08.04.2024, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure and in compliance to the order dated 22.03.2024, cost of Rs. 6,000/- has already been deposited vide receipt No. 1501 dated 03.04.2024, copy of which is also enclosed.

4. Respondent No. 2 is represented by his counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

5. In view of the aforesaid report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "*Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another*", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant-respondent No. 2

has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/ accused person.

6. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0433 dated 27.10.2023, under Sections 323, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise (supra) qua the present petitioner.
