It is informed that the judgments relied upon by the petitioners in the cases of *Ajay Kumar Singla & Others vs. State of Punjab and others in CWP-17064-2017, decided on 16.02.2023; Rajinder Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and others in CWP-7382-2019, decided on 27.03.2023; Dr.Vishvdeep Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others in CWP-6391-2016, decided on 26.10.2018; and Gurwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others in CWP-8922-2017, decided on 13.09.2018*; are subject matter of challenge before the Supreme Court in *SLP (Civil) No.24345 of 2023/Diary No.41783/2023* titled as *State of Punjab and others vs. Ashish Swaroop and others*, wherein the Supreme Court has passed an interim order staying the operation of the said judgments passed by this Court.
