The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 102 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 against the order dated 26.02.2024 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge (Children's Court), Chandigarh in criminal appeal No.73 of 2024 as well as order dated 11.01.2024, passed by Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Chandigarh in FIR No.85, dated 19.03.2023, under Sections 307, 120-B, 302 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh vide which the bail application of appellant child-in-conflict with law was dismissed.

This Court vide order dated 04.04.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and respondent-State of UT Chandigarh was asked to file reply, if any.



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Today, no reply has been filed by learned Addl. P.P. for UT Chandigarh and he is not in a position to controvert the prayer made in the petition.

Consequently, the order dated 04.04.2024 is made absolute. The Trial Court shall consider the personal/surety bonds already furnished by the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
