1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 18.11.2022 passed in CWP-16031-2020.
2. Affidavit of Sudhir Rajpal, Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana, School Education Department, Chandigarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 18.11.2022 passed in CWP-16031-2020 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 01.11.2023 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
