The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India for directing the Arbitrator-cum-Divisional Commissioner, Patiala to consolidate the challenge made by NHAI, as well as, by the petitioner to the award made by the competent authority and their claim determination of the Market Value/Compensation of land acquired and to decide the petition/application for enhancement/redetermination of market value/compensation against the award No.69 dated 27.09.2021 passed by CALA-cum-DRO, Ludhiana after affording opportunity to the petitioner, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.
