AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the prayer made is for quashing of transfer order dated 23.09.2023, Annexure P-7, whereby he has posted at Penengla, 1066 Field Workshop, which is at more height than Rongli, 130 RCC, which was one of the four choice stations admittedly given by him as stated in para 8 of the petition, in terms Instructions ROI, Annexure P-3, that entitled an employee to make after having served in the high altitude.

2. Further stated that at the relevant time, though the vacancy was available in Rongli, but the same was filled up by posting a person holding a lower rank of Store Supervisor, while the petitioner is a Senior Store Supervisor. Be that as it may, he has been during the pendency of the present petition, deployed to 86 RCC at Rangma Range, which is on even a higher altitude besides being about 135 kms ahead, rendering the instructions, P-3, as meaningless.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts, learned counsel appearing for UIO had during the course of arguments taken time to obtain instructions and having

received the same from Mr.Vikas Kharey, Officer Commanding 1066 Field Workshop, submits that the matter in question shall be sent in a week’s time to GREF Records, Pune for being reviewed.

4. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. Disposed of accordingly. The decision be taken by the competent authority within a period of 8 weeks after being received.
