This revision petition has been filed by the plaintiff to assail the trial court's order refusing to permit the petitioner to amend the plaint. The court has found that the amendment is not necessary. It is only an elaboration of the existing averments.

This Court has also examined the proposed amendment. The view of the trial court does not suffer from any error. The plaintiff has already filed a suit for recovery of Rs.10,00,000/- as damages on account of the loss of reputation, which contains the necessary averments. The plaintiff is entitled to lead evidence to prove the same.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
