JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) whereby respondent has declared 25.01.2019 as date of promotion of petitioners as DSP.

2. The petitioners claim that their entire batch has been granted promotion as 'DSP' w.e.f. 25.12.2016 whereas petitioners have been granted seniority w.e.f. 25.01.2019 which is manifestly arbitrary and discriminatory. The petitioners have filed representation dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) but to no avail.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, at the outset, submits that representation of petitioners is under active consideration and an appropriate order would be passed within 3 weeks' from today. The petitioners have also filed objections to seniority list which are under consideration.

4. In the wake of statement of learned State Counsel, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioners to avail remedies as permissible by law, if they feel aggrieved from the order passed by the respondent.
