RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.08.2023 passed in CWP-20422-2022.
2. Pursuant to the order dated 02.08.2023 passed in CWP-20422-2022, counsel for the respondent has produced copy of communication dated 22.09.2023 addressed to the petitioner, vide which copy of revocation letter dated 11.02.2021 is provided to the petitioner. Copy of communication dated 22.09.2023 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to continue with the present petition any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
