The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs.9,42,435/- qua certain works in Assembly Constituency Raja Sansi and Amritsar Central.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) upon respondents No.4 and 5 but the respondents have neither taken any action thereupon nor did they make the payment to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.4- The Executing Engineer, Central Works Division No.2, PWD B&R Branch, Amritsar is directed to

consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

The learned State Counsel does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said legal notice, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
