Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and unmarried but are into live-in-relationship which is opposed by respondents No.4 to 6 who are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 18.3.2024 (Annexure P-3) was given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action against the private respondents.

2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. J.S.Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.
4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to consider representation dated 18.3.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is

any threat perception to the petitioners.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 6 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
