SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointment of Warrant Officer for the release of the detenu namely Parshant, who has been illegally detained by respondents No. 5 to 9.
2. This Court while issuing notice of motion on 20.03.2024, following order was passed:-

“The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been invoked for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointment of a Warrant Officer for the release of the detenue namely Parshant aged about 26 years, who is stated to be in illegal confinement of respondents No.5 to 9, who are none other than his father and his family members.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Sr. DAG Haryana, who is appearing on advance notice accepted the same on behalf of official respondents. Copy of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day. Learned State counsel is directed to produce the alleged detenu in the Court on the next date of hearing.

List on 05.04.2024.”

3. In compliance of the afore-said direction the alleged detenu has been produced in Court, who stated that he wants to live in the company of petitioner. Respondents No.5 and 7, who are father and brother-in-law (Jija) of the alleged detenu, are present in Court today and have stated that they have no objection in case the alleged detenu joins the company of the petitioner.
4. In view of above, no further order is required to be passed. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed off, as such.
