1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, challenging the orders dated 04.01.2002 (Annexure P-1), 14.01.2003 (Annexure P-2) and 15.01.2003 (Annexure P-3) respectively, whereby the recovery of Rs.7,15,468/- was ordered against the petitioner.
2. While issuing notice of motion on 06.10.2003, it was ordered that no recovery shall be made from the petitioner till the next date of hearing and the said interim order is continuing till today.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.03.2017 and thereafter, unfortunately died on 23.03.2023. He further submits that all the retiral benefits of the petitioner have already been released.
4. In this view of the matter and with the efflux of time, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
5. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
