1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the order dated 01.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No. 1 in case filed under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 by respondent No. 4, ordering the eviction of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No. 4 have jointly submitted that respondent No. 4 has died and has further prayed that the matter be disposed of at this stage with the observation that the impugned order not be implemented and liberty be granted to the LRs of respondent No. 4 to file an application for revival of the present petition, in case any cause survives with the said LRs.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with the observation that the order dated 01.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) would not be implemented. Liberty is granted to the LRs of respondent No. 4 to move an application for revival of the same on showing their legal rights and in case any cause survives.
