By way of present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made to grant anticipatory bail in case FIR No.459 dated 10.11.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 186 and 224 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tauru, District Nuh.

2. Allegations are that in connection with an investigation of case FIR No.294 dated 29.10.2023, under Sections 379-A and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 7 IMT, Manesar, a police party had gone to arrest accused Sarukh Khan and Talim alias Talli, when they called petitioner Ratti, who reached the spot alongwith 20-25 persons armed with deadly weapons, attacked the police officials, caused injuries to them and got Sarukh and Talim alias Talli released from the police custody.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated and that it is not believable that from the police party, the petitioner will not be able to get the accused released.

4. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

5. After hearing learned counsel for both the sides and going through the record, this Court does not find any ground to grant the banefit of anticipatory bail, considering the nature of allegations as made in this petition against the petitioner.
